How is your information used?

Our Web server automatically recognizes the IP address and action of each visitor. We use individual information for error tracking, to help diagnose problems with our server, and to administer the Web site only. The aggregate information on what pages are visited is used only to improve the content of our Web pages. Your IP address is used to help identify you and your shopping cart during an e-commerce based transaction.

Our website's RSVP form requires users to give us contact information (name, company name, email address, phone number, accreditation-if applicable (CPP, PSP, PSP). We use this information for confirmation of your attendance at an ASIS Toronto Chapter 193 sponsored event, presentation, or education seminar or study group.

The information from the RSVP form also allows representatives of the ASIS Toronto Chapter 193 to contact an individual in the event of a cancellation of the event. The customer's contact information will be used to contact the individual/s when necessary.

We will only use a telephone number you supply us with to contact you regarding a transaction that you have placed with ASIS Toronto Chapter 193 www.asistoronto.org . We will not call you regarding promotions and we will not share your phone number with anyone.

COOKIES

Our site uses cookies to keep track of your shopping cart. You have the option of setting your browser to reject cookies. However, if our cookie is rejected, we will not be able to keep items in your shopping cart and you will not be able to complete your order online. For you to complete your order, you must allow www.asistoronto.org to use a cookie.

SECURITY

This site has security measures in place to protect the loss, misuse and alteration of the information under our control. We utilize industry standard SSL encryption when accepting your personal and financial information during our online checkout process. SSL encryption is a method by which information transmitted across the Internet is scrambled to the point where it's indecipherable by anyone who should intercept the data before it reaches its destination.
