Entrance Scholarship

Eligibility Period – application packages are accepted **November 1st** to **September 30th** of each year

Open To – certificate, diploma and bachelor security studies programs

Intent – first year, first semester students regardless of method (full time, part time, continuing education) are encouraged to apply to the entrance scholarship. Students whose credits exceed one semester worth of credits in a security studies program at the time of the application will not be accepted.

Award Schedule – this award will be given out at the Law and Security Practitioners Awards dinner in October of each year. The recipients will also enjoy a complimentary dinner at this event. Transportation is not provided. An invitation including details and location will be sent to the winners of this award.

Bursary

Eligibility Period – application packages are accepted **November 1st** to **May 1st** of each year.

Open To – certificate, diploma, bachelor and master's security studies programs

Intent – first year, second year, third year, fourth year and fourth year + students regardless of method (full time, part time, continuing education) are encouraged to apply to the bursary. This bursary is open to any student regardless of how many credits they have. In addition a student who is graduating in that academic year is also eligible to participate in the bursary.

Award Schedule – this award will be given out at the Law and Security Practitioners Awards dinner in October of each year. The recipient will also enjoy a complimentary dinner at this event. Transportation is not provided. An invitation including details and location will be sent to the winner of this award.

Scholarship

Eligibility Period – application period is **November 1st** to **May 1st** of each year

Open To – diploma, bachelor and masters security studies programs

Intent – first year (may apply as long as they pass all their course work and will be transitioning to the second year of studies), second year, third year, fourth year and fourth year + students regardless of method (full time, part time, continuing education) are encouraged to apply. A minimum of a 75% percent average for all course work must be maintained in order to be eligible for this award. In addition a student who is graduating in that academic year is also eligible to participate in these awards.

Award Schedule - this award will be given out at the Law and Security Practitioners Awards dinner in October of each year. The recipients will also enjoy a complimentary dinner at this event. Transportation is not provided. An invitation including details and location will be sent to the winners of these awards.

Writing Competition

Eligibility Period – application period is **November 1st** to **May 1st**

Open To – certificate, diploma, bachelor and master's security studies programs

Intent – first year, second year, third year, fourth year and fourth year + students regardless of method (full time, part time, continuing education) are encouraged to apply. A requisite of this award is that the student is enrolled in a security studies program. In addition a student who is graduating in that academic year is also eligible to participate in this award.

Award Schedule – this award will be given out at the Law and Security Practitioners Awards dinner in October of each year. The recipient will also enjoy a complimentary dinner at this event. Transportation is not provided. An invitation including details and location will be sent to the winner of this award.
