Best Practices Seminar:

- Attendance was 90 registrants at Villa Columbo.
- First time ASIS Toronto paid for premium speakers.
- 2013 - Date set for April 18, 2013 – Markham Event Centre
- Received 9 submissions for speaking in 2012

Law Enforcement & Security Practitioner: Bill Anderson, CPP

- Overall the 2012 event was a success with average ratios of attendance of paying versus 'guest' attendees. This was despite having three less police agencies participate this year. There were 77 pre-registered guests, down slightly from 2011.
- As opposed to prior years, we reduced this years 'ticket' price accepting an acceptable partial loss in order to promote a broader scope of attendance.
- This year represented the addition of the Military Police, who were honoured to participate.
- Tentative date of October 10th, 2013 at Panamonte Banquet Hall booked (coordinated to avoid conflict with other industry events).

Certification Committee: Mike Thompson CPP, PCI, PSP

The ASIS Toronto Chapter 193 continues to be very active in promoting and supporting the Professional security designations CPP, PSP, and the PCI. During the calendar year 2012 we held two separate study group programs for all three designations.

- Spring 2012 we held the study groups at the OPG head offices on University and we had an excellent complement of participants: CPP 22 attendees, PSP 10 attendees, PCI 6 attendees.
- During the fall of 2012 we held the second annual 2 day weekend seminar for all three designations at Ryerson University Although the participation was not as strong as the spring sessions, we did see that those who attend this 2 day session are using this as a final preparation for writing their exam.
- Approx 50 % of The attendees of this 2 day study session Held in October had applied to write their exam.
- In the PCI designation study session we even had an attendee who resides in Vancouver who attended this session as a final step in his study plan. (he did notify us that he was successful in obtaining his PCI designation)

ASIS Toronto Chapter 2013 Goals:

- Increase Chapter membership
- Increase security awareness in the industry by planning and promoting security events
- Maintain communications with Plaque Sponsors ensuring participation with chapter events.
- Establish calendar of monthly events in first quarter so chapter members can plan their attendance well in advance.




ASIS Toronto Chapter 193 Election Results:
